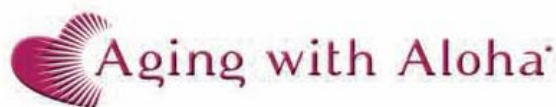

**Aging with Aloha® Coalition Annual Meeting Set

The Aging with Aloha® Coalition, formerly known as the Maui Long Term Care Partnership, will hold its annual meeting on June 23 at The Maui Tropical Plantation.

Two panels are set to update participants about workforce education and development and home and community based services issues and projects.

Panelists addressing the workforce topic include:

- √ *Nancy Johnson*, Allied Health Department Chair, Maui Community College, who will share an update about the Long Term Care Curriculum Pilot Project;
- √ *Anne Trygstad*, Kula Hospital, who will share the hospital's experience in implementing a worker retention initiative taught through a VITEC developed Compassionate Caring and Continuous Improvement course.

Panelists addressing home and community based services include:

- √ *Deborah Arendale*, Maui County Office on Aging Executive and Coalition Chair, who will share an update about Hawai'i's Aging Network, a planned Aging and Disability Resource Center, and directions with aging programs;
- √ *Tony Krieg*, CEO/President, Hale Makua Health Services and former Coalition Chair, will share an update about the Maui PACE (Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly) and the State Long Term Care Commission;
- √ *Senator Rosalyn Baker*, District 5, South and West Maui, will share an update about the recent legislative session and the impact on programs and services for older adults, caregivers, and persons with disabilities.

Clifford Nae`ole, Cultural Advisor to the Ritz Carlton, is the luncheon guest speaker. He will address "*The Promise of Aging with Aloha®*". The afternoon sessions consist of conversation with Kupuna to obtain their mana`o about aging well and "aging with aloha".
